

Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

Minutes for: 10/14/19

Chairman Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. In attendance were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr and seven members of the public.

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from public hearing and regular meeting held on September 30, 2019 approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Plans

155 Mohawk Trail – consolidation/lot line revision, Kenneth Graber. A discussion ensued about the items that need to be completed on this plan.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the consolidation/lot line revision for 155 Mohawk Trail, Kenneth Graber, contingent on the following items being completed: 1. Complete the application checklist. 2. The plan will need to show all of the items noted in Section 302 of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, 3. Show topography on the plan, 4. Show the water well location on the plan, 5. Show the sewage disposal system location on the plan, 6. Show the floodplain on the plan. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

449 Grove City Road - Baker/Shipton – lot line revision (right-of-way). A short discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made the motion to approve the lot line revision for 449 Grove City Road, Baker/Shipton for a 50' right-of-way. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

157 Bradman Estates - Cupak – consolidation/lot line revision. A short discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made the motion to approve the 157 Bradman Estates, Cupak, consolidation/lot line revision. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Slippery Rock Library – reported to the board that the library computer system had a cyber-attack and are working on the restoration. Several fund-raisers are being planned. Requesting additional donation for 2020 for \$1.00 per person in the township.

Unfinished Business

SR Library sidewalk project bid came in, the township share is \$24,000.00 (township committed \$9,000.00). A short discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to commit to the original amount of \$9,000.00 the SR Library sidewalk project and table the additional \$15,000.00 money requested until further information can be obtained as to reason for the extra cost. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Other Business

2020 Budget – review, will be on next meeting agenda.

Speed Study – speed reduction requested section of Miller Road from borough line to the entrance of the SRU Miller Trails entrance, a short discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to approve the speed study for Miller Road from the borough line to the SRU Miller Trails entrance. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

CDBG Grant application – signature page, Paul Dickey signed.

Spare sewer grinder pump – a short discussion ensued and it was determined that no extra pump is necessary.

Ordinance #2019-3 – Speed Limit reductions, tabled until the completion of the Miller Road speed limit study.


Correspondence


