3. **Clean up day** – should this be cancelled 4/25/20, a short discussion ensued.


*John Hines made a motion to cancel clean-up day on 4/25/20 until further notice. Paul Dickey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*


4. **Pay employees and continue benefits** - while furlough because of the Coronavirus, a short discussion ensued.


