# **Slippery Rock Township Supervisors**

**Minutes for: 6/10/19** 

Chairman Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 8:01 p.m. in attendance was Supervisor John Hines and Terry Doerr along with Rick Grossman, planning consultant. David Neill, engineer was absent. Seven members of the public attended.

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes for May 28 2019, approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

#### **Executive Session**

The board went into executive session at 8:02 p.m. until 8:18 p.m. to discuss a legal and personnel issues.

## **Open Comment(s)**

Residents, Michael Formeck and Mary Hines-Formeck plus Scott & Kristina Slattery were present with concerns of water run-off from Sunshine Acres along Miller Road, running into their front yard and driveways causing washouts. Discussion ensued. Paul Dickey acknowledged the problem and will survey the problem along Miller Road and see if any remedies can be done. The office or the board will communicate any resolutions to the residents.

#### **Plans**

<u>SRU Credit Union</u> – stormwater management discharge easements. Rick Grossman added that the TWP had requested that the Credit Union look at the discharge into the pond that the Fowler property originally put in for the original development. SRU Credit Union furnished the SR TWP with a copy of an agreement, reviewed by David Neill and Rick Grossman that shows the easement the Fowlers have agreed to and there is a legal drainage easement that would be constructed, operated and maintained by SRU Credit Union. The office will forward it to the solicitor for review and advice.

<u>Phipps Lot Consolidation</u> – Rick Grossman summarized the SRPC recommendation to the board for approval consideration contingent on the set-backs along the private right-of-way being 15 feet per the SR TWP zoning regulations. A brief discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the Phipps Lot Consolidation contingent on the set-backs along the private right-of-way being 15 feet per the SR TWP zoning regulations. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Paul stated that we have ordinances and related resolutions on the books and the Township will be enforcing the ordinances and resolutions accordingly. The inspections and testing will be done by the appointed Sewage Enforcement Officers.

Paul Dickey made a motion that SR TWP will enforce the sewage ordinance and resolutions associated accordingly with inspections and testing to be conducted by the appointed Sewage Enforcement Officers. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

3. Mowing – SR TWP Buildings lawns. Paul noted that the need of hiring a lawn service for the Township buildings. The office is to contact a few lawn care services in the area to get quotes and availability as needed and coordinate.

Paul Dickey made a motion to contact several lawn care services for quotes and availability and use as needed. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
