

# Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

## Minutes for: 7/27/20

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. In attendance were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr. Also in attendance were Mike Hnath, solicitor, Dave Neill, engineer, and three members of the public.

*John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 13, 2020 meeting, approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*

### Open Comment(s)

**Lorraine Shaffer, Kid's Innovation Playground**, program for Cyber Security, this is a community service to teach children about cyber security. A short discussion ensued.

*John Hines made a motion to allow Lorraine Shaffer, Kid's Innovation Playground, to use the building for the dates requested rent free for the community program, Cyber Security, but if this becomes a for profit business then rent will need to be paid to the township for the use of the community room. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*

### Plan

**Dreyer Lot Consolidation** – SRPC letter and items needed. Greg Jones represented this plan and reviewed the items the planning commission requested. A short discussion ensued.

*John Hines made a motion to approve the Dreyer lot consolidation contingent on Butler County Planning Commission review and comments. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*

**SRU Soccer Field** – Dave Neill handled this issue. A short discussion ensued with Terry Doerr reminding Dave that Kiester Road will need to be bonded for the project.

*Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the SRU Soccer Field land development contingent on the road bond being in place. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*

### Engineer's Report – Dave Neill

**Sanderson Road project** – project is completed and the contractor is finalizing the project with the County.

**Pavilion project** – budget for project has been completed. Coordinating with the county for bidding of the project. Paul suggested that shade trees will need to be planted.

**SRU Soccer Field land development** – this was handled under the plan portion of the meeting.

**Other Business**

**Bradman Estates** - large rocks in right-of-way at 157 Bradman Estates, map & parcel# 280-S10-D32, a short discussion ensued.

*Paul Dickey made a motion to send a letter to the property owner requesting the rocks to be removed from the right-of-way or the township will remove them and bill the property owner. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*

**Storage of picnic pavilion until built** – Dave Neill reported that there has been an extension from CDBG for this project so the picnic pavilion and restroom can be purchased in the spring.

**Public Hearing** – August 24, 2020 @ 2:30 p.m. for zoning and map amendment, a short discussion ensued.


**CDBG Coronavirus** – funding, a short discussion ensued on how to appropriately distribute the money.

**BCPC** – had no comments on proposed zone change for parcel # 280-4F70-14J. No action was needed or taken on this correspondence.


**Paul Dickey** asked if there is any additional or further business - none


*Terry Doerr made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3:30 p.m. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.*
