- 2020 Meeting Dates. A brief discussion ensued and these dates will be discussed at the next meeting.
- Special Exception request for 857 Franklin Road. Tracy Frampton summarized comments from the Butler County Planning Commission, Rick Grossman Community Planning Consultant/Assistant Zoning Officer, and Mark Lazzari, EADS Group Assistant Temporary Zoning Officer as follows:
 - 1. BC Board of Commissioners Economic Development this variance is supported as outlined by Municipal Code and Subdivision and Land Development.
 - 2. Mark Lazzari, EADS Group provided a summary of 3 options for the property owner's consideration. Tracy noted that the special exception option included much of the same content as Rick Grossman's summary.
 - 3. Rick Grossman submitted a detailed regulations of six items and/or conditions that should be met or addressed by the special exception.

After further discussion, the planning commission recommended that all of Rick Grossman's conditions be met, with the exception of waiving the condition to use screen planting along the West side and North side or rear of the property. He also recommended to limit the hours of operation from 7am – 9pm.

Jack Lawson made a motion to recommend to the Zoning Hearing Board for the Special Exception for 857 Franklin Road to consider the six items and conditions per Rick Grossman's report of detailed regulations waiving the condition to use screen planting along the West side and North side or rear of the property plus limit the hours of operation to 7am – 9pm. Bob Steele seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
