PART 1

Smoking Regulations

§101. Prohibited Actions.

The smoking or carrying of a lighted pipe, cigarette, cigar or tobacco in any form is prohibited in the areas herein provided. (Ord. 23, 11/9/1987, §1)

§102. Smoking Prohibited in Certain Areas.

Smoking shall be prohibited where conditions are such as to make smoking a hazard, including areas of piers, wharves, warehouses, stores, industrial plants, institutions, schools, places of assembly and in spaces where combustible materials are stored or handled. The Supervisors shall designate specific safe locations, if necessary, in any building, structure or place in which smoking may be permitted. (Ord. 23, 11/19/1987, \S 2)

§103. Authority of Township Supervisors.

Now the Supervisors are empowered and authorized to order the owner or occupant to post "No Smoking" signs in each building, structure, room or place where smoking shall be prohibited. Said designation of a smoking hazard as determined by the Supervisors shall be made by way of formal resolution to be adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors. The content, lettering, size, color and location of required "No Smoking" signs shall be subject to the approval of the Supervisors. (Ord. 23, 11/9/1987, §3)

§104. Removal or Tampering With Signs Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to obscure, remove, deface, mutilate or destroy a posted "No Smoking" sign. (Ord. 23, 11/9/1987, §4)

§105. Unlawful to Throw Lighted Substances.

It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke, throw or deposit any lighted or smoldering substance in any place where "No Smoking" signs are posted. (Ord. 23, 11/9/1987, §5)

§106. Ashtrays and Match Receivers.

Where smoking is permitted, there shall be provided on each table and at other convenient locations suitable noncombustible ashtrays or match receivers. (Ord. 23, 11/19/1987, §6)

§107. Penalties.

A violation of this Part shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$50. (Ord. 23, 11/19/1987, \$7; as amended by Ord. 2/12/2002)

§108. Designated Areas.

The Township Supervisors of Slippery Rock Township hereby designate the properties of the Slippery Rock Area School District as areas of smoking regulation, and further direct the owners and/or administrators of said properties to submit plans to the Slippery Rock Board of Supervisors within 30 days of their receipt of a true and correct copy of this duly adopted Section, said plans to provide for areas of permitted smoking and areas of prohibited non-smoking and further shall provide for the posting location, content, lettering, size, and color of appropriate regulatory signs. Should said owner and/or agent fail to remit plans within the specified time period or should said plans as submitted fail to meet with the approval of the Board of Supervisors, then said Supervisors shall adopt, through their own initiative, a plan to be imposed upon the owner and/or agent of said properties. Any costs incurred by the Township of Slippery Rock in implementing the guidelines for this Section shall be collected from the owner and/or agent as provided by law. (Res. 11/9/1987)
