

Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

Minutes for: 3/22/21

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. In attendance, were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr along with Solicitor, Mike Hnath, two members of the public attended in person and one person attended via Zoom.

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from the 3/8/21 meeting, approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Open Comment(s)

Joe Nash – introduced himself and explained he is running for District Justice.

Scott Albert, SRU – attending via Zoom addressed the board concerning the sewer agreement between the township and the university. A short discussion ensued with the outcome being the university will amend the agreement to include the picnic pavilion restroom.

Unfinished Business

Campus Side Apartments – false fire alarms, a short discussion ensued. Mike Hnath is to review this issue and make his recommendation to the board.

Public Hearing – new solar & wind regulations Chapter 27 and changes to junkyard Chapter 13 – set public hearing date and time, a short discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to set the public hearing for May 24, 2021 and 2:45 p.m. for the solar and wind regulations to be added to Chapter 27 and the changes to the junkyard, Chapter 13. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Other Business

Tree Cutting bid for Stoughton Road – on Stoughton Road beginning at Slippery Rock Road and ending at Crestview Road, a short discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to approve the tree-cutting bid for Stoughton Road in the amount of \$8,000.00. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Suit-Kote Crack Fill 64-22 with fiber – proposal, a short discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the Suit-Kote bid in the amount of \$7,125.00. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Painting – boardroom, vestibule, kitchen, and restrooms, a short discussion ensued with the outcome being to get several bids for this project.

Butler County Council of Governments – appoint voting delegate, a short discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to appoint Paul Dickey as the voting delegate for the Butler County Council of Government (BC COG). Terry Doerr seconded, Paul Dickey abstained from the vote. The motion carried unanimously.

CDBG draw down – approval and signature, a short discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the CDBG draw down in the amount of \$5,611.77 for submittal to the County for payment. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence

Slippery Rock Area School District – Saniga Road bus stop, a short discussion ensued with the outcome being the township cannot make any changes to this area to improve the bus stop. Paul Dickey will help draft a letter to the school district.


