

Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

Minutes for: 4/26/21

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:23 p.m. In attendance were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr, solicitor, Mike Hnath one member of the public in person and one member of the public via zoom.

This meeting began late due to a 2:00 p.m. meeting running over. The meeting was with the Pennsylvania State Police, Pennsylvania Liquor Control Officer, SRU Campus Police, SRU Student Conduct personnel, SR Borough Police, managers of the off-campus housing developments, and Paul Dickey and Mike Hnath representing the township.

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 12, 2021 meeting, approve and pay the bills, and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Open Comment(s)

Joe Kubit – running for Butler County Common Pleas Judge, addressed the board with his qualifications for the position.

Unfinished Business

Bldg. Code Board alternate – tabled

Emergency Management Coordinator, a short discussion ensued.

Paul Dickey made a motion to appoint John Hines as the Emergency Management Coordinator. Terry Doerr seconded, John Hines abstained from the vote. The motion carried unanimously.

Painting bids – for the vestibule, restrooms, conference room and kitchen. One bid received. A short discussion ensued.

Paul Dickey made a motion to accept the painting bid from Unique Construction in the amount of \$2,030.00 for interior painting. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Picnic Pavilion – pre-bid meeting was set for May 4, 2021. The EADS Group cannot have the paperwork ready for the May 4, 2021 date. A short discussion ensued with the outcome being that if the pre-bid meeting needs to be moved to May 18, 2021 with bids due on June 8, 2021 and bid opening on June 9, 2021 that is acceptable to the board.

CDBG –Cemetery Road – income surveys, a short discussion ensued. Paul Dickey would like to survey the residents of Cemetery Road to see if they would be interested in public water and sewage. Karen Connell will check with the appropriate people to see the process of moving Cemetery Road up on CDBG plan of road repairs.

Terry Doerr made a motion to move Cemetery Road to the top of the CDBG projects. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Other Business

Higher Information Group – digital imaging of records, a short discussion ensued, with the outcome being for the office to investigate and get quotes on cost.

Marcia Carnahan – signage on Stoughton Road in regards to engine retarder brakes, a short discussion ensued with Mike Hnath investigating the use of brake retarders.

Meeting with Sgt. Zandarski – Paul Dickey reported to the board, this was the meeting prior the board meeting. The state police requested this meeting with the Township, the Borough, Slippery Rock University, and the off-campus housing management. The police have reported that there are numerous issues with the off-campus housing having parties getting out of control. There have been numerous arrests due to residents having illegal guns, drugs and underage drinking. The township will enforce Ordinance 2017-2 (Outdoor Sound Systems/Outdoor Entertainment) and Ordinance 2017-3 (Nuisance Gathering), but in order to enforce the off-campus housing management will have to give the township the names of the residents in violation of these ordinances.

Case Sabatini – 2020 audit is completed and submitted to DCED, but will have to be amended due to PMRS not having the pension information needed for the audit.


BC Hazard Mitigation Plan – 5-year update of the plan. Butler County will be reviewing the plan this year and will adopted by fall.

Paul Dickey asked if there was any additional or further business, none.


Terry Doerr made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3:46 p.m. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
