

Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

Minutes for: 7/26/21

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. In attendance were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr along with Mike Hnath, solicitor and two members of the public in person and two members of the public via zoom.

John Hines made a motion to approve the July 12, 2021 minutes, approve and pay the bills, and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Open Comment(s)

Craig Caldwell – Sunshine Acres, addressed the board concerning the township taking over the six cul-de-sacs in the Sunshine Acres Development. A short discussion ensued the office will research to see how the cul-de-sacs were built, if there are any as-built drawings. The board is not in favor of taking over these cul-de-sacs.

Other Business

Hazardous Mitigation Plan – John Hines – The township is currently in compliance. John suggested that the township review the updated Butler County Hazardous Mitigation Plan and piggy-back on this plan.

Engineering study – the State Police received a complaint that overweight trucks are on Stoughton Road. The outcome of the discussion is that the township and Allegheny Mineral have a maintenance agreement for Stoughton Road. No engineering study needs to be done.

Covid-19 – funding, a short discussion ensued with the outcome being to try and investigate how this money can be spent in the community.

CDBG Housing Rehab – contract, this needs to be signed due to the changes to the CDBG grant project.

CDBG – 2021 funding allocation, a short discussion ensued with the outcome being for Dave Neill, engineer, to begin the design and cost estimate for McCandless Road and then Pink Road.

Sunshine Laws – The new sunshine law will take place on August 29, 2021.

American Rescue Funding - a short discussion ensued, funding must be obligated by 2024, funding must be spent by 2026.


Geotech Engineering Inc. – response to letter from township concerning stormwater and zoning requirements, no action was needed or taken on this correspondence.

Additional or Further Business – none


Terry Doerr made a motion to adjourn at 3:46 p.m. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
