

Slippery Rock Township Supervisors

Minutes for: 9/12/2022

Vice Chairman, John Hines called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Supervisor, Terry Doerr was present. Chairman, Paul Dickey was absent. David Neill, engineer, attended via zoom. Seven members of the public attended the meeting.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 22, 2022 meeting, approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Open Comment(s)

A group of residents living approx. between ¼ - ½ mile west of Arrowhead Drive attended the meeting with the following concerns: *A lengthy discussion ensued.*

1. Drainage issue along that part of Miller Road and their driveways being washed-out plus washed-out area around catch basins.

The Supervisors along with David Neill explained the TWP findings and repair of a crushed culver/pipe under Miller Road leading to this drainage issue. Terry Doerr reported that the roadcrew is scheduling to clean the ditches along that road with the grader within 1-2 weeks to help with the water flow.

2. Speed limit concerns along sections of Miller Road.

The speed limit of 25 mph was discussed and noted the correct areas that are currently within the 25 mph which include the section from the SR TWP/SR Boro boundary to .50 miles west of Arrowhead Drive. The signage will be placed to reflect this area along Miller Road. Terry Doerr reported that the road crew is scheduling as soon as the correct number of signs are available. Further discussion ensued in regards to the remaining sections of Miller Road to the bridge and beyond asking to reduce speed limit in those areas. David Neill relayed information in regards to the speed studies and how it is determined.

3. Enforcement of speed limits.

Further discussion ensued in regards to the remaining sections of Miller Road to the bridge and beyond asking to reduce speed limit in those areas and means to enforce these speed limits. David Neill relayed information in regards to the speed studies and how it is determined.

John Hines stated that the board will continue to work with the residents to evaluate solutions as noted above. The board elected and announced to continue discussion with residents at their next regular meeting.

Engineer's Report – Dave Neill reported on the following:

- Arrowhead Drive Culvert – project proceeding and includes restoration and paving.
- Salt Shed – Waiting for proposal for design and construction.
- Grants/Kiester Road PennDOT Multimodal transportation fund Grant application/BC Infrastructure Bank – Project identification area/CDBG funds for road construction or potentially moved for Bowman Lane/Bowman Lane Income Survey.
- Stormwater issues – Miller Road – Some of this report was discussed earlier with residents in the Open Comment section included; drainage pipe crushed and repaired. Investigation of an optional discharge for the storm sewers and ditches on the north side of Miller Road plus it is possible to install another discharge to the west of 175 Miller Road. EADS will complete preliminary sizing of the system, should the Township wish to install the piping the future.

Other Business

1. **Crossroads Baptist Church, 302 Harmony Road** - completed paving 8/7/22-8/8/22 as noted and required on their land development plan recorded 4/21/2017. TWP received a letter and copy of the “paid in full” invoice.

2. **PMRS** – 2023 MMO. A brief discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion to approve the Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for Plan Year 2023 as submitted. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

3. **PSATS – Federal Broadband money grant information.** Tracy Frampton, EADS reported that the County is taking the lead on pursuing funding for broadband expansion and would expect they would pursue this or other sources of funding. No further action needed.

4. **BCATO - 38th Annual Safety Seminar** – Oct. 12th. A brief discussion ensued.

John Hines made a motion for SR TWP municipal employees to attend and pay for reservations. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously

5. **Miller Road** – speed limit issue. This was discussed during the open comments and Engineer report.

6. **Part-time Temporary Road Crew** – Aaron Orient. Discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to hire Aaron Orient as a Part-Time Temporary Road Crew with the wages to-be-determined. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

7. **105 Mohawk Trail Sewage Module Approved.** Dep reported the plan revision is approved and does still require an NPDES (Part 1) permit plus a Water Quality Management (Part II).




John Hines asked if there was any additional or further business - None


