Slippery Rock Township Supervisors Minutes for: 9/26/2022

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. In attendance was Supervisor Terry Doerr, Engineer, Dave Neill, Solicitor, Anthony Cosgrove, along with seven members of the public. Supervisor John Hines was absent.

Terry Doerr made a motion to approve the minutes from September 12, 2022, approve and pay the bills, and approve the financial report. Paul Dickey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Open Comment(s)

Miller Road – residents had the following concerns, a short discussion ensued. The crushed culvert pipe has been repaired and the cleaning the ditch line has been put into the road maintenance schedule. It was reported that the speed limit sign is blocked by another sign. Paul Dickey will have the road crew look into this issue.

Scott Albert, SRU – reported the following to the board:

- 1. Still working on funding for the ROTC and Campus Police project.
- 2. Stormwater pond bids will be opened on September 29th with the project to begin in January 2023.

Engineer's Report - Dave Neill

Arrowhead Drive – culvert project update, the final inspection will be on September 27, 2022 then final payment will be submitted.

Salt shed – proposal from Inscale Architects for the Gordian Salt Shed, a short discussion ensued.

Paul Dickey made a motion to approve the proposal from Inscale Architects in the amount of \$12,071.05 for the design of the salt shed. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Kiester Road – grants update, Multimodal grant will be awarded later this fall or early 2023. No word on the Butler County Infrastructure Bank, the project area has been identified and submitted to the County.

Bowman Lane – sewer and water extension update, several residents were in attendance concerning this issue. Income surveys have been returned and it is about 50% in favor and 50% not in favor of extending water and sewer to Bowman Lane.

Miller Road – stormwater issues update, this issue was discussed under Open Comments.

Other Business

PennDOT – proceeding with a conflict warning system for the intersection of Route 8 and Branchton Roads, a short discussion ensued. This was tabled until after the October 4, 2022 meeting with PennDOT officials.

PennDOT – suggested improvements at the Route 8 and Branchton Roads Intersection, a short discussion ensued. This was tabled until after the October 4, 2022 meeting with PennDOT officials.

Kiester Road – County bridge deterioration, a short discussion ensued. No action was needed or taken on this issue.

BC Association of TWP Officials - 2022 Annual Fall Convention- Oct 26th – RSVP Oct 12th. Paul Dickey and Terry Doerr will attend.

William Flynn Highway - request for PennDOT to perform a speed study in area from Kiester Road (T841) to State Route 108 (2.4 miles) along State Route 8 (William Flynn Hwy). This was tabled until after the October 4, 2022 meeting with PennDOT officials.

Resolution #22-9-1 – turnback Miller Road repairs – Butler County and Lawrence County line relocation, a short discussion ensued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to adopt Resolution #22-9-1 to receive \$20,650.00 for repairs to a portion Miller Road, this portion of road that was obtained from Plain Grove Township, Lawrence County due to the County line relocation. Paul Dickey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

PLP Co. – line painting quote, a short discussion ensued.

Paul Dickey made a motion for PLP Co. to do the line painting for the township in the amount of \$11,643.66. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence

BC Commissioners – SB 477 – changes in assessed valuation, building and demolition permits reporting, no action was needed or taken on this correspondence.

BC Tax Claim Bureau - Map & Parcel 280-S3-A84-0000 to be sold for less than owed in real estate taxes.

Paul Dickey made a motion to approve the sale of Map & Parcel # 280-S3-A84-0000 for \$1,000.00 even though the real estate tax owed is \$1,940.87. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

PennDOT – replacement of Kelly Bridge (Crestview Road) in Worth Township virtual public meeting 10/3-10/17, 2022, no action was needed or taken on this correspondence.

Paul Dickey asked if there was any additional or further business, none.

Terry Doerr made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3:38 p.m. Paul Dickey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
