3/27/2023


Chairman, Paul Dickey called the 1st public hearing for FFY 2023 CDBG to order at 2:45 p.m. In attendance were Supervisors John Hines and Terry Doerr and one member of the public attended.

Wendy Leslie, Butler County Grant Coordinator, addressed the board:


1. This is the first of two public hearings for the 2023 CDBG grant,
2. Preparation of the 2023 CDBG application has started,
3. No indication of the 2023 allocations, but should be similar to 2022 CDBG which was \$125,754.00,
4. Currently the township has \$194,096.00 to put toward the McCandless Road project,
5. Projects must meet the low to moderate income standards,
 - a. McCandless and Pink Roads income surveys were completed in 2020, they will expire in 2025 if the projects are not completed by then,
6. Township needs to consider the 3-year activity plan, a discussion ensued:
 - a. Road projects
 - b. Slum/Blight house removal
 - c. Urgent need for immediate use in case of catastrophe disaster


Paul Dickey made a motion to adjourn the public hearing at 2:52 p.m. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.


