# Slippery Rock Township Supervisors Regular Minutes for: 02/26/2024

Chairman, Paul Dickey called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. In attendance was Supervisor, Terry Doerr, Vice Chairman, John Hines, along with Solicitor, Mike Hnath. Five members of the public attended.

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 12, 2024 regular meeting plus approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

### **Open Comment(s)**

<u>Corporal Kotuby – PA State Police</u> – A PSP representative tries to get to one meeting a month in each municipality in Butler County. Corporal Kotuby gave statistics of calls in and around the Township since September of 2023: (10) criminal mischief investigations, (20) vehicle crashes (5 DUI, 1 fatal), (60) traffic stops (9 DUI), (7) assaults, (6) burglaries, (9) disorderly conducts, (10) drug arrests. The Supervisors made Corporal Kotuby aware of a party that is said to be occurring at University Village on Saturday, March 2, without permits from Slippery Rock Township or approval from the ownership of University Village.

Scott Albert – SRU – Project updates: SRU is responding to the comments on the NPDES permit for Kasnevich Field, the pond dredging and culvert installation under Kiester Road will be bid out next month, the renovations to the old SRU Union are still on track to finish in July 2024, the ARC roof will begin in the next month or so. SRU will be soliciting input from SR Township and the local community to start a mini master plan for athletic and outdoor recreation spaces on the SRU Campus.

<u>Dave Hollenbaugh – SRU</u> – Explained that it is probable that SRU will be able to shift the funding from the RACP Grant that was awarded to build the ROTC/Police building to the Cozy Homes Senior Living project since the ROTC/Police Building has been discontinued.

Terry Doerr made a motion to sign the modifications to the RACP grant application to shift the focus of the funding to the Cozy Homes project from the ROTC/Police Project. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Interns from SRU and GPS mapping</u> – had initial meeting with Jack Livingston and the interns from SRU. Work will start soon on this project.

#### **Butler County Council of Governments**

Paul Dickey made a motion to pay the \$100 fee to join the Butler County Council of Governments. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>eCodes update</u> – discussed how to move forward with this project to review and answer the questions outlined by eCodes for the Township.

<u>Holding Tanks</u> – will review sample ordinance from Doug Duncan, SEO to deal with holding tanks in our ordinances.

<u>Clean-up Day</u> – will choose a Saturday date after SRU graduation (May 3 & 4) to hold our annual Township Clean-up Day.

<u>SRU – signatures for updated Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program</u> – motion made during the Open Comment period to sign the updated RACP Grant application.

<u>PennDOT agreements for Miller Road and Dight Road</u> – Paul Dickey will review these agreements.

John Hines made a motion to sign the PennDOT agreements for Miller Road and Dight Road once reviewed. Terry Doerr seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
