- North Creek Drive drainage project There is a pipe on the abandoned section of North Creek Drive that has failed. The township is responsible for the drain although the road is abandoned the drain handles all the water from Fergus Road. There is a plan to reroute the water behind the garage on a property along North Creek Drive into a ditch along Rt 258. Jason Allen, Road Foreman, has received quotes for pipe and catch basin.

  Paul Dickey made a motion to proceed with the North Creek Drive drainage project in the amount of approximately \$4,602.00. John Hines seconded and the motion carried
