APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

John Hines made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2026 regular meeting plus approve and pay the bills and approve the financial report. Jason Allen seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

OPEN COMMENTS:

Scott Albert – SRU received the DCED Multimodal grant. This was done in collaboration with Slippery Rock Borough and will be used for sidewalk improvements. The renovation work for the Police Station has been put out to bid.

Tracy Frampton, EADS Group – The Board discussed obtaining political backing for the grants the Township has applied to.

Paul Dickey made a motion to authorize The EADS group to put together a presentation to present to local politicians. Jason Allen seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

David submitted report and Paul Dickey read report as follows:

Grants

- LSA Application for Back Up Generator at Township Building submitted.
- DCED Multi Modal Transportation Fund Grants will open in March 2026. This could be used potentially for Hines Road
- Act 13 Grant programs are open until May 31st. Options include:
DCED Flood Mitigation Program (FMP) – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program (GTRP) – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Sewage Facilities Program – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Abandoned Mine Drainage Abatement – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Baseline Water Quality Data Program – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Orphan or Abandoned Well Plugging Program – Act 13 Grant Program
DCED Watershed Restoration and Protection Program – Act 13 Grant Program

John Hines made a motion to pay the cost for training for new members up to \$1,400.00 using funds from Act 13. Paul Dickey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

- **Possible truck purchase** – A discussion ensued about replacing the 550 – small dump truck. Paul and Jason are looking at possibly bidding on a used truck on Muncibid.

Paul Dickey made a motion to authorize bidding on any truck on Muncibid up to \$60,000. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

- **Repair of Community Building carport** – A quote was received from Unique Stone Construction for repairing the Community Building carport.

Jason Allen made a motion to accept the quote from Unique Stone Construction in the amount of \$3,885.00 for the repairs on the Community Building carport. John Hines seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
