## Minutes for: 1<sup>st</sup> CDBG Public Hearing

The 1<sup>st</sup> public hearing for FFY 2026 CDBG was held on March 23, 2026 at 2:45 p.m., in the Slippery Rock Township Building located at 155 Branchton Road, Slippery Rock, PA 16057.

#### **CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 2:47 p.m. by Paul Dickey.

#### **FFY 2026 CDBG PROGRAM – Wendy Leslie, Butler County Grant Administrator**

1. Wendy Leslie, Butler County CDBG Administrator, addressed the board:

- The purpose of the hearing is to afford the public an opportunity to provide input into the 2026 CDBG program.
- This is the first of two public hearings for the 2026 CDBG grant to afford the public input into the use of the program funds.
- The 2026 allocations are unknown as of yet, but should be similar to the 2025 CDBG allocation of \$122,957.00. The breakdown for the 2025 funds was \$100,899.00 in activity funds and \$22,058.00 in administration funds.
- Funding must to be used to benefit low/moderate income areas or low/moderate income residents. It can also be used for spot blight or urgent need whereas the urgent need must be catastrophic.
- Past projects utilizing CDBG funds have been the Phase I and Phase II road improvement projects on McCandless Road, housing rehabilitation, park improvements and road construction.
- Wendy gave a reminder that all activity funds are to be spent in the first three years of the grant.
- The Township has received no written or verbal comments about today's hearing.

- A discussion occurred on the possible uses of the 2026 funding.
