Public Hearing Minutes
June 8, 2026**

The public hearing of the Slippery Rock Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 8, 2026 at 7:45 p.m. in the Slippery Rock Township Building located at 155 Branchton Road, Slippery Rock, PA 16057.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Paul Dickey, called the public hearing to order at 7:47 p.m.

OPENING STATEMENT BY SOLICITOR:

Anthony Cosgrove made the opening statement as follows: This is a public hearing on a proposed zoning ordinance amendment pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

Anthony asked any members of the public or any members of the Township who would like to testify on the record of the hearing to raise his/her right hand and be sworn in by the Court Reporter.

Anthony Cosgrove entered into record the following exhibits:

1. The proposed Ordinance No. 2026-01
2. Notice of this Public Hearing and proof of the advertisement that was run in the Butler Eagle on May 24, 2026 & May 31, 2026
3. Minutes of the April 13, 2026 Slippery Rock Township Planning Commission (SRPC) meeting where the SRPC gave the recommendation on the proposed Ordinance
4. Butler County Planning Department Review Report of these Ordinance Amendments

ASSISTANT ZONING OFFICER:

Ryan Countryman stated that the Planning Commission had made a recommendation to the Supervisors to authorize campgrounds in the R-2 district. Amendments have also been made in the RC-1 district with regards to Recreational Campgrounds to keep the process the same for both districts. Recreational Campgrounds would be a Conditional Use approved by the Board of Supervisors. Upon further review of the proposed ordinance, in section 308.3 subsection F, the current proposal says "The design of any outdoor lighting shall prevent glare and consistent with 406.F". This should say "The design of any outdoor lighting shall prevent glare and be consistent with 406.F"

Anthony explained the decision-making process for the adoption of this ordinance. This will be up for discussion and vote at the regularly scheduled supervisors' meeting held immediately following this public hearing.
