ZONING OFFICER REPORT – RYAN COUNTRYMAN:

Ryan reminded everyone that the Supervisors will be holding a public hearing tonight at 7:45 p.m. for an amendment to Chapter 27 of the Township Code of Ordinances sections 306 and 308, revising requirements for recreational campgrounds. At the Supervisors regular meeting at 8:00 p.m. there will be an ordinance amendment on the agenda for Chapter 27 Sections 306 and 308 and for an amendment to Chapter 6 to reinstate section 302.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Discussion on battery storage facilities** – Mary-Margaret Hertz from Crow Holdings Renewables and Andy Miller from MPL Law Firm were present. Mary-Margaret presented information on Crow Holdings and details on Battery Energy Storage Systems (“BESS” or

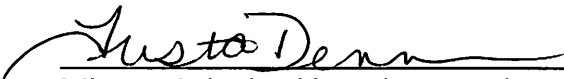
“Energy Storage”). She discussed a proposed project in the township located on Kiester Road behind the Baptist church and across from the existing electric substation. Discussion followed with a number of questions from the members and staff. Ryan stated that this type of project would require more investigation with regards to the permitting process and if and how this type of facility is addressed – or not addressed in the ordinance.
